



RULES FOR VISITORS

Art Fort Lauderdale

Security inspection

- For safety and security reasons, all visitors and their belongings are subject to a thorough inspection before boarding the water taxi.
- All visitors must comply with requests and instructions from the onsite security staff.

Bag policy

- Backpacks, suitcases and trolleys of any size are not allowed.
- Only one bag per person is allowed.
- Art Fort Lauderdale reserves the right to refuse the bringing in of any items that do not comply with this policy and is not responsible for items deposited in the coat check.

Items not allowed at properties

- Backpacks, suitcases, trolleys of any size
- Umbrellas and any other items that might cause damage with the exception of small foldable umbrellas
- Firearms, self-defense and/or any sharp items
- Drones
- Recreational wheeled devices (e.g. Segways, rollerblades, skate boards, bicycles, scooters, etc.)

Permitted mobility aids and medical equipment

- Mobility aids for people with disabilities (e.g. wheelchairs, crutches, walkers, canes, prosthetic devices and other orthotic devices) are allowed. **Please note because the fair is on the water and means of travel is by water taxi any individual requiring a wheel chair will need special arrangements to arrive to the properties by car and should schedule the visit with show management in advance.*
- Personal medical equipment is allowed

Cameras and visitor photography policy

- Personal/- non-professional use photography is permitted, however it must be conducted without disruption to the show or visitors, and with the safety of the artworks in mind.
- Compact or small-format cameras no larger than 6" x 5" x 3" (16cm x 12cm x 8cm) in size are permitted. In addition, one lens, no more than 80mm in focal length, is permitted.
- The following are prohibited: Medium or large-format cameras, super-zoom or telephoto lenses, flashes, extendable camera devices (e.g. monopods, tripods, selfie sticks, etc.), drones and video recording.
- UniteUs Group management reserves the right to decline entry of any device that does not clearly comply with this policy.
- Please note that press and promotional photography and filming are taking place on the premises. Attendance at the fair implies permission for your image to be used for non-commercial purposes (including media reports).

Marketing materials

- The distribution of flyers and any other marketing materials is subject to authorization. Unauthorized distribution will result in the visitor being asked leave the fair and all materials will be removed immediately.

Service dogs and assistance animals

- Dogs and other pets are not permitted at show properties, with the exception of certified service animals for visitors with disabilities.
